



III. Conditions and requirements Eligibility - general

- The transnational consortium must consist of at least three independent eligible legal entities from at least three SUSFOOD2 partner countries listed in Annex 3
- The application must be written in English
- Projects should have a maximum duration of 36 months
- The requested total budget cannot exceed 1.5 M € per proposal (requested funding)
- Total eligible budget of a partner cannot exceed 70 % of the total eligible project budget in order to achieve balanced partnerships and ensure that responsibility and risks are shared
- Registration to the Meta Knowledge Base (MKB) is compulsory (see next chapter 6.1)



YOUR QUESTION

"Research" vs "Research & Innovation" proposals?

- "Research" proposal consists of research organisations
- "R&I" proposal has industry involved
- This distinction is only meant for proposals in total
- It is independent of national funding possibilities (e.g. a funding organisation can only fund "Research"; still he can fund a partner who is part of a "R&I" proposal)



III. Conditions and requirements Proposal outline

- Pre-proposals consist of
 - Infos on partners (coordinator + partners)
 - Infos on project (duration, keywords, abstract, description of work, financial plan)
- All information is entered online to the submission platform
- The pre-proposal will be automatically created

It is <u>not</u> possible to change core information from pre- to fullproposal (e.g. partners, finances) unless asked by evaluators or funding agencies!




