

The CORE Organic is a **network of 26 European ministries and research councils from 19 European countries/ regions** funding research in organic food and farming on transnational level since 2004.

The objective of CORE Organic is to improve knowledge basis and innovation capacity necessary for supporting further development of organic food and farming to respond to significant societal challenges in Europe's agriculture and food systems.

FOSC ERA-NET Cofund on Food Systems and Climate

- FOSC is the European Research Area Network (ERA-Net) Cofund action on Food Systems and Climate.
- FOSC started in October 2019 and will run for 5 years until September 2024 (possible extension due to Covid)
- The FOSC consortium consists of 28 partners from Europe, Africa and Latin America

Main challenge of FOSC is

• To contribute to the achievement of **food and nutrition security** under **climate change** within the context of **sustainable food systems**, considering the three dimensions of sustainability (social, environmental, and economic).




- **➤ Joint Call SUSFOOD2/ CORE Organic Cofund:**

 - > Launch: September 2019, final selection: June 2020













